To our members:

One year ago, few predicted the dramatic economic downturn that the country, the state of New Hampshire, and the non-profit sector have since experienced. Nationwide, losses to endowments and investments by universities and other institutions have been a staggering 30 percent or more. The Forest Society was not immune.

We celebrate the fact that thanks to the generosity of our donors and the overall strength of our financial position, we are weathering the storm—other organizations are not so fortunate. Despite the challenges of the year and the losses to our invested assets, thanks to our land protection successes, we added nearly \$7 million in land value to our balance sheet.

During the fiscal year, we made some extremely difficult decisions in order to reduce our operating budget to what we feel is a sustainable level under current conditions. With reductions of staff and certain programs, we cut our annual expenses by 20 percent, as compared to the previous year.

But we are a mission-driven organization. As important as the financials are to our long-term viability, the Forest Society exists—as it has since 1901—to protect New Hampshire's most important landscapes and promote wise use of its natural resources. So let us measure an otherwise unpleasant year not by dollars won and lost but by how we advanced our mission.

We conserved 6,284 acres through 27 land protection projects. Among them, 11 were new fee-owned forest reservations or additions to existing reservations, while 16 were conservation easements. We now steward 165 forest reservations totaling nearly 48,000 acres, and monitor more than 700 easements on more than 115,000 acres.

Our land protection successes were highlighted by the completion of our Connecticut River Forest project that yielded the new 2,100-acre Washburn Family Forest Reservation. Located in Clarksville, it features not only working forest and significant wildlife habitat, but more than six miles of frontage on the Connecticut River. More than 800 donors made it possible to raise over \$2.8 million to make the conservation of this remarkable forest possible. Today it is our largest reservation north of the notches.

In the Lakes Region, thanks to an extraordinarily generous bargain sale, we acquired the 431-acre Evelyn H. and Albert D. Morse, Sr., Preserve, which includes a commercially viable

blueberry barren and spectacular Winnepesaukee views from the top of Pine Mountain in Alton.

In the coastal watershed, we acquired the 282-acre Salmon Falls Forest, protecting nearly a mile of frontage on the Salmon Falls River in Milton Mills. Within the Quabbin-to-Cardigan focus area, we successfully acquired a conservation easement on 960 scenic acres on the northern slopes of Ragged Mountain in Hill. The March Pond Forest abuts 750 acres of conserved land in Andover and protects a number of small streams that feed Danbury Bog and the Smith River—one of the most pristine tributaries of the Merrimack River.

And there is more to come. Future land conservation prospects are strong—including our 1,750-acre Ashuelot River Headwaters project in southwestern New Hampshire, which we are working hard to complete by December 1, 2009. And we have more than 50 land conservation projects in the making, many of which are donations of conservation easements in areas of strategic importance identified in our regional conservation plans.

Meanwhile, even as we keep our collective eyes on the lofty goals of our strategic vision, New Hampshire Everlasting, our board of trustees and staff continue to examine how we accomplish those goals—how we steward our lands, how we build support, how we communicate with our members. If there is one lesson to be learned from the changes of the last 12 months, it is that few assumptions can go unchallenged. Our mission remains same, but a shifting world demands that we adapt our tactics.

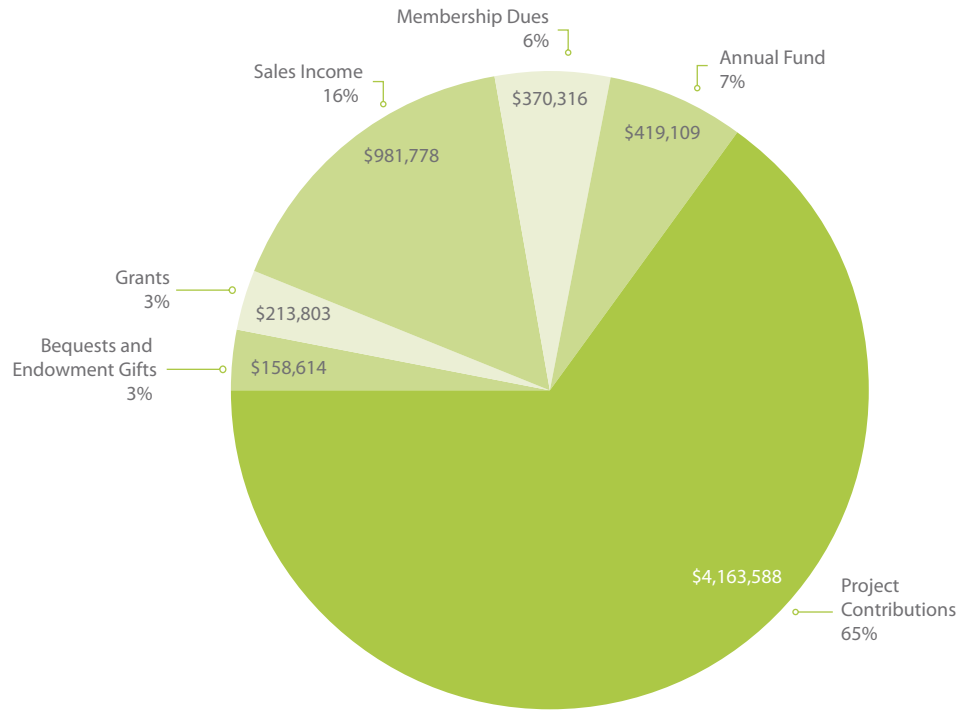

Financial Highlights

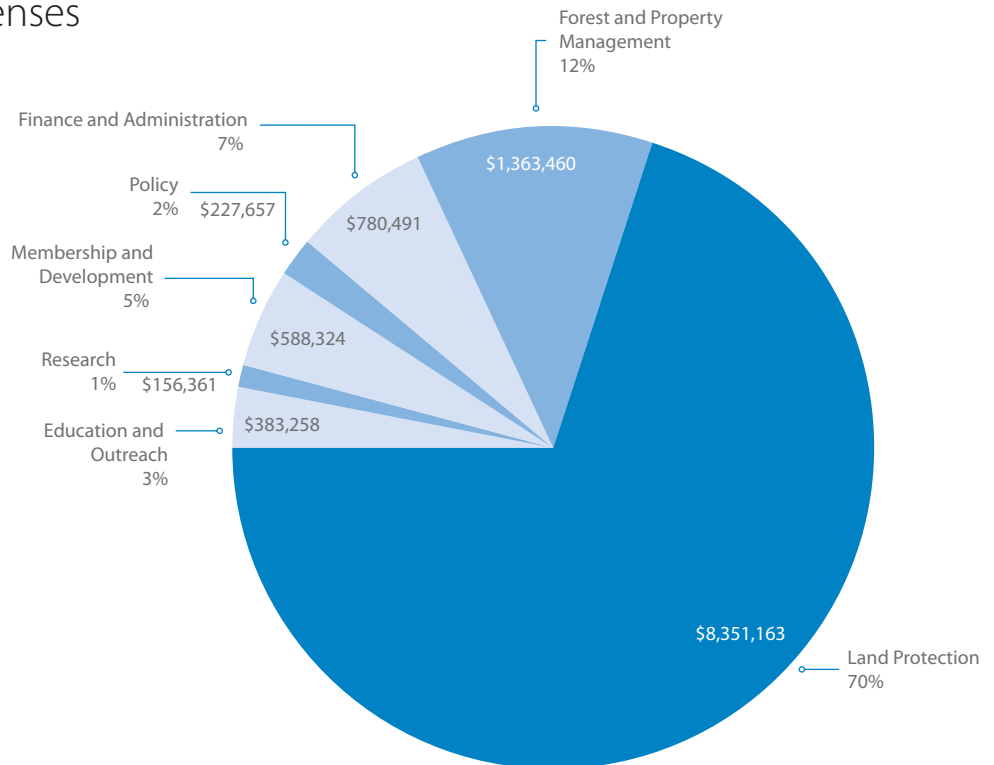
Fiscal Year 2009 Program Revenue

This chart shows the breakdown of Forest Society revenue received in fiscal year 2009. Almost two-thirds (65%) of all funding was used to support specific land conservation projects, including the purchase of land and conservation easements. These Project Contributions include both unrestricted support as well as funds restricted to specific projects, which are expended when the conditions for their use have been satisfied. Sales income generated from Christmas tree and timber sales, the Forest Society's gift shop, rental income, and fees charged for services comprised 16% of all revenue. Contributions to the Annual Fund and Membership Dues (7% and 6% respectively) support the Forest Society's general operations.



Fiscal Year 2009 Program Expenses

During fiscal year 2009 operating expenses totalled just over \$4.5 million, and \$7.2 million was spent on land purchases. Land management and protection accounted for 82% of the total expenses. Education, Policy, and Research combined accounted for 6% of the total. Membership and Development accounted for 5% of the total, and Administration accounted for 7% of total expenses.
